

Presentation of the online “UV/Vis⁺ Photochemistry Database” at the International Conference on Photochemistry (ICP2021)

The 30th edition of the International Conference on Photochemistry (ICP2021) will be organized virtually from July 19 to 23, 2021. The conference was initially planned to take place in Geneva, Switzerland. The virtual conference will be as similar as possible to an event happening onsite and will offer many new opportunities. The organizing and the scientific committees are working hard to prepare an attractive and exciting scientific program, which covers the most recent advances in photochemical and photophysical sciences in their broadest sense, and reflect the new frontiers in these fields. All participants will be able to attend sessions, watch plenary and invited lectures, explore networking opportunities, exchange with other attendees via the powerful virtual conference platform provided by the conference organizing agency the organization committee teamed up with for this event.

During the last weeks we have had discussions with the organization committee and the conference organizing agency. The result of this discussion is that we will have the opportunity to present the “UV/Vis⁺ Photochemistry Database” on the conference virtual platform to all participants. Information concerning the database as well as full access to the online database (datasheets, spectral data, graphs etc.) will be available in an “informative session”, which will be available on the timeline of the event during every day.
